What: On the water sailing school

When: Weekdays, July 6 through July 18, 2009

Where: Missouri Yacht Club, Lake Lotawana, MO

Who is eligible: Any resident of Lake Lotawana with a basic understanding of sailing. Boats will be provided by Missouri Yacht Club.

Times: 8:30 a.m. to noon, Introductory class; 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m., advanced class.

Ages: The classes are open to all ages

Missouri Yacht Club is sponsoring for the second year a sailboat racing class at its facility at Lake Lotawana. The class, open to participants of all ages, is designed to teach fundamentals and advanced concepts of sailboat racing to sailors who already possess a basic understanding of sailboat racing.

The cost for the class is \$25 per week, though skippers are strongly encouraged to enroll for both weeks. The class will be led by Jim Young, a nationally recognized sailing instructor. Jim is a past Butterfly national champion. He also holds Olympic coaching experience.

Classes will be conducted in the Optimist Pram. The Pram is used because its stability in strong wind conditions.
